Submission of Applications for Certificate of Origin						
Purpose	The purpose of the Preferential Country of Origin (PCO) module is to facilitate the application, processing and issuance of Vanuatu Certificates of Origin (CoO), in the Vanuatu Electronic Single Window (VeSW) system. This facilitation ensures that issued CoO are consistent with the different Rules of Origin (RoO) of the various Free Trade Agreement (FTA), as well as the Vanuatu's Basic Certificate of Origin (BCO).

	3. Once the PCO Application form is completed, the Applicant should					
	submit it along with the required attachments.					
	4. If the PCO Application is for a product that is already approved for					
	the Exporter under a given FTA, the Applicant will receive the					
	certificate automatically from the system.					
	5. Otherwise, the Customs Admin Officer(s) will receive an email to					
	check the application in the system and the Officer responsible can					
	either:					
	5.1 Send the application back for query, in which the applicant					
	should address and re-submit; or					
	5.2 Modify the application themselves; or					
	5.3 Reject the application if it is not in order, capturing the reasons					
	for the rejection in the system.					
	6. If the application is in order, the Admin Officer will accept the application.					
	7. Customs may wish to inspect the product to insure it conforms with					
	the RoO of the FTA concern. The inspection results must be captured					
	in the system.					
	8. Once inspection is completed, the Authorized Customs Officer will					
	receive an email to approve or cancel the application.					
	9. Once the application is approved, the Certificate of Origin will be					
	ready for printing or downloading from the system.

Actions	the Customs Technical Unit will consult them for the sake of voluntary compliance.					
	Customs may also take legal action against Applicants who make					
	continuous errors/omissions.					
	3. Customs may deregister a product if it does not comply with the					
	Rules of Origin of the Free Trade Agreement.
