

Chapter 99 – Part 2B (Import Duties Act – Schedule I)

Note: To facilitate exempted consignments under Chapter 99, the Chapter 99 HS codes have been abbreviated in the VeSW system to be used as additional codes. This is particularly useful on PC4 entries that have been automatically generated from CDS-ASYHUB, with goods that are classified according to kind.

Other codes under Chapter 99, other than 991 and 998 which are restricted to postal items only, can also be used to clear goods under Chapter 99 at other ports of entry.

Extract from Part 2B notes:

In 9902.00.00 (or 992) and 9903.00.00 (or 993) the expression “personal effects” and “household effects” are not to be taken to apply to cigarettes, cigars, tobacco and alcoholic beverages.

In 9901.00.00 (or 991) a document includes:

- a) All forms of written material; and
- b) All information recorded, transmitted, or stored by means of tape recorders, computers or other devices, and all material subsequently derived from information so stored or recorded; and
- c) Labels, marking and other forms of writing that identify anything of which they form part or to which they are attached by any means; and
- d) Books, maps, graphs, and drawings, and
- e) Photographs, films negatives, tapes and other devices in which one or more visual images are embodied so as to be capable to be reproduced (with or without the aid of some other equipment)
